About The Program:

Department of Management Studies Had organized Faculty Development Program for Sandip Foundation Faculty Members on the Topic “How to use Case Study a a teaching aid”. The Program was conducted by Dr Pradeep Pendse (Dean We School Mumbai).He said Case method is a powerful student-centered teaching strategy that can impart students with critical thinking, communication, and interpersonal skills. Having students work through complex, ambiguous, real world problems engages students with the course material, encouraging them to “see it from an action perspective, rather than analyze it from a distance”. Case studies are, by their nature, multidisciplinary, and “allow the application of theoretical concepts...bridging the gap between theory and practice” Working on cases requires students to research and evaluate multiple sources of data, fostering information literacy. Case method is also effective at developing real world, professional skills. Working on case studies requires good organizational and time management skills. Case method increases student proficiency with written and oral communication, as well as

collaboration and team-work. “Case studies force students into real-life situations,” training them in managerial skills such as “holding a meeting, negotiating a contract, giving a presentation, etc”
