While the initiative is still in its early stages, the progress has been promising, with the institute partnering with a few universities around the globe and participating in various collaborative activities.



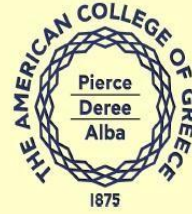
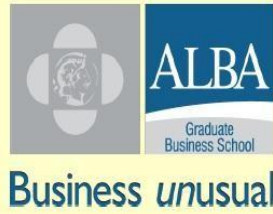
