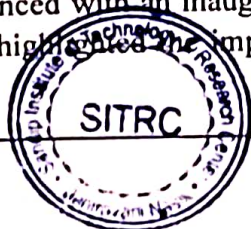
**Objective:**

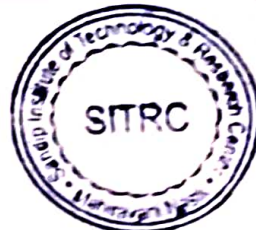
