Objective:

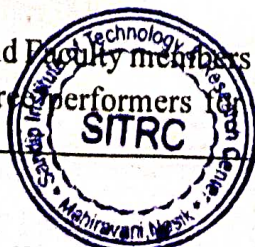
1. The event aimed to honour Mahatma Gandhi on his 154th birth anniversary by commemorating his life, principles, and contributions to India's freedom struggle.
