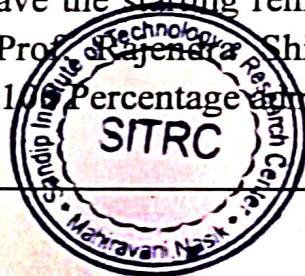
Objective:

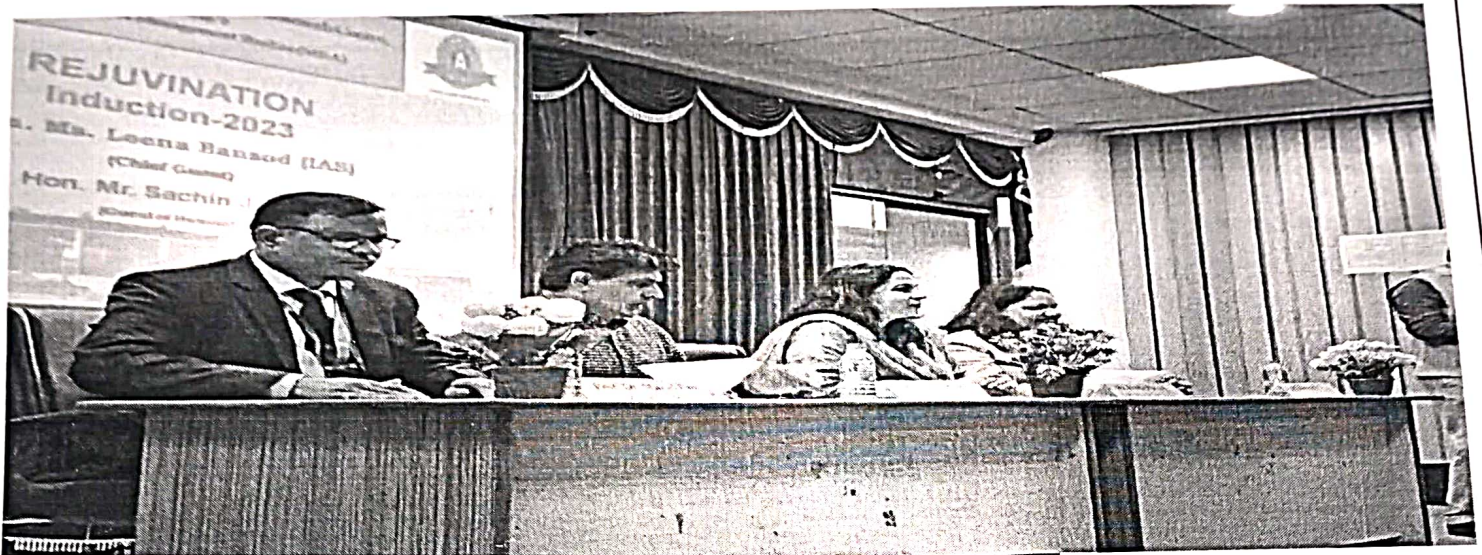

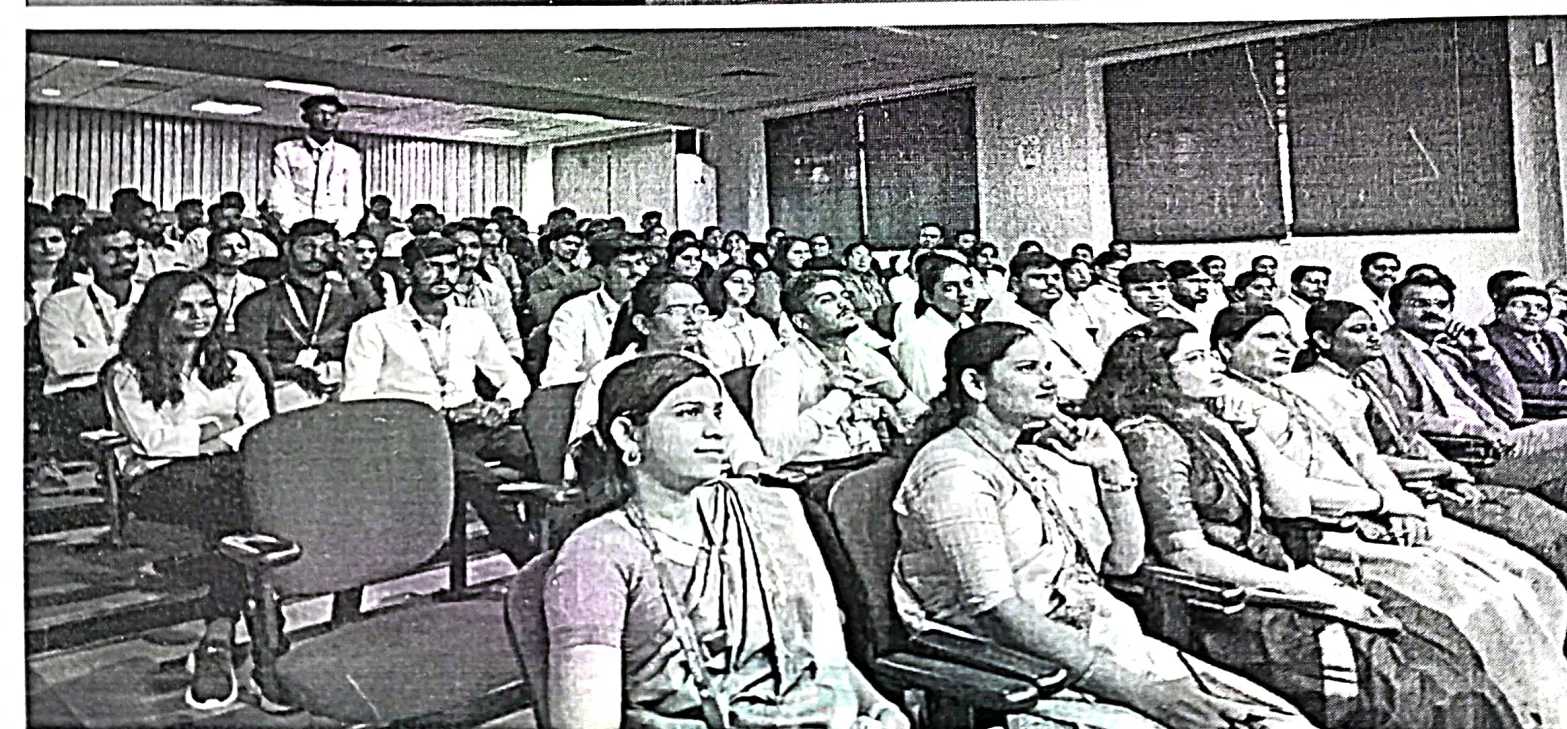
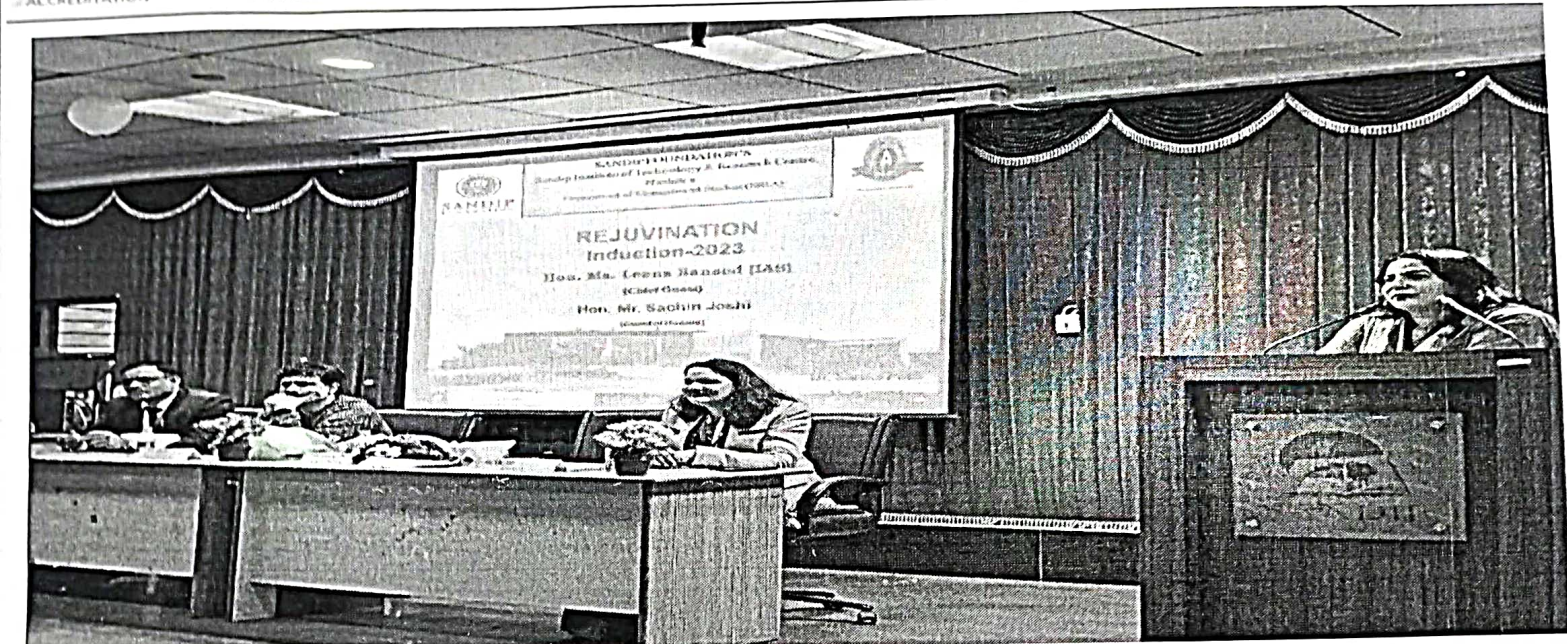
