About The Program:

Sandip Foundations: Department of management studies organized the Battlefield on the 27th and the 28th Jan 2023, the battlefield helps in inculcating the spirit of entrepreneurship among students and provides them an opportunity to execute their theoretical knowledge in the real world, It helps in developing a leadership Skills, team skills, soft skills, and decision-making skills overall it helps in developing the overall personality of the students preparing them for the corporate world

The activity was divided into various phases the first phase was

Phase I: Preparation for the battle began in September, with the identification of leaders. Students were given a stage to come up with a speech to appeal to students to join their respective teams. Phase II: Selection of ideas and prepare for the battlefield It was the brainstorming phase of the battlefield. Each team had to come up with innovative ideas for their stalls. 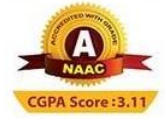




