students with a deep understanding of the Union Budget by discussing its highlights and analyzing its implications. Students engaged in pre-budget economic analysis, sector-wise

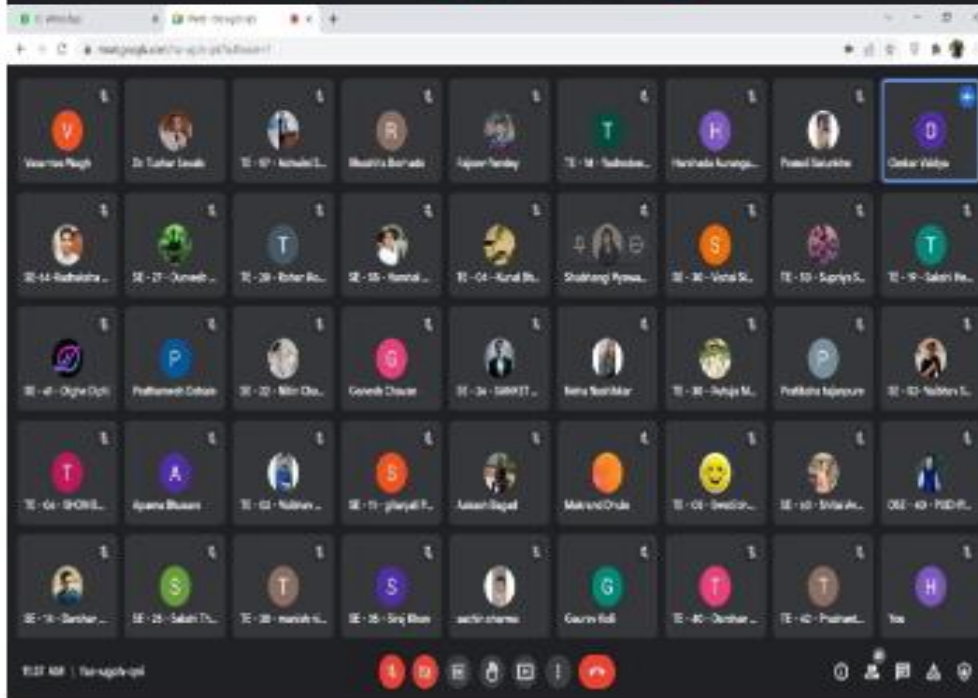
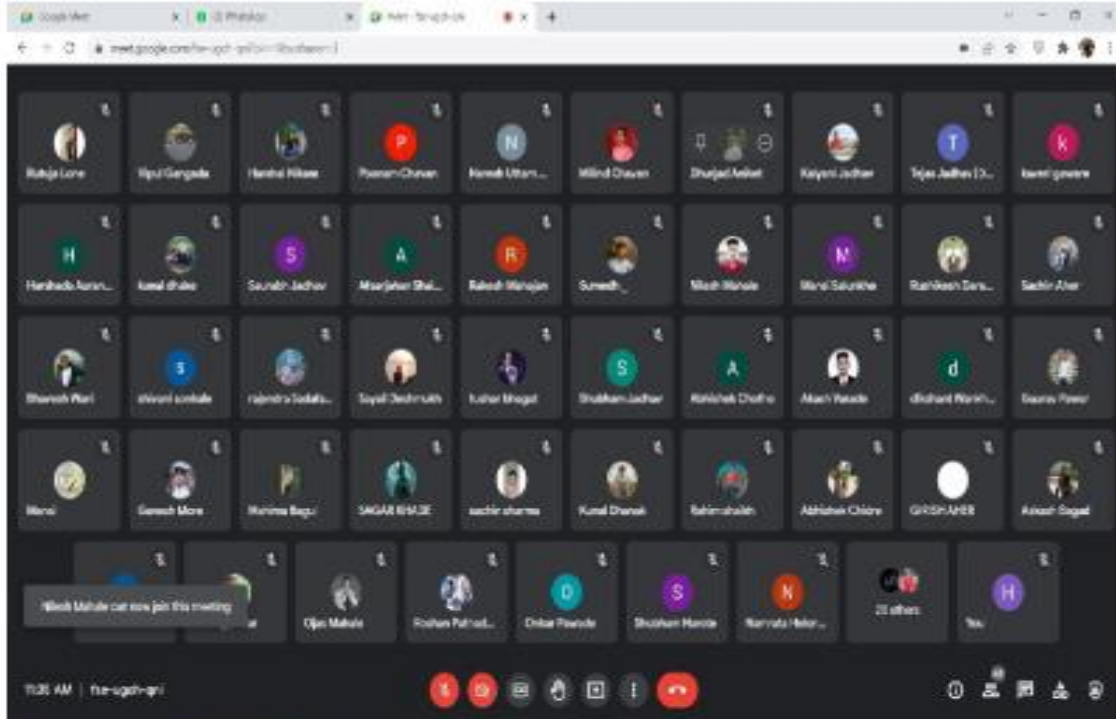
