About the Program:

The Department of Management Studies, in collaboration with Sandip TBI, organized a highly informative and engaging lecture titled "**Crafting Your Career from What You Love**" for students. This session aimed to assist students in aligning their passions with their career aspirations. The seminar's standout feature was its exceptionally young guest speakers: Mr. Jainam Jain, 12 years old, and Ms. Jivika Jain, 10 years old, along with Ms. Mamta Jain.

The lecture provided invaluable insights and practical advice on converting personal interests into successful career paths. Ms. Mamta Jain started the session by guiding students through exercises to help them identify

their core interests and passions, emphasizing the importance of understanding and embracing what they truly enjoy. She also addressed common mistakes in students' routines, such as unstructured study habits, frequent distractions, and a lack of discipline, and highlighted the need for a structured study approach and consistent discipline.

Ms. Jain introduced SMART goals, stressing the need for objectives to be Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant, and Time-bound, and recommended the Pomodoro Technique to enhance focus. She also emphasized pursuing hobbies, encouraging students to passionately engage in their interests for personal fulfillment and career growth.

Mr. Jainam Jain shared his personal experiences, advising students on how to turn their hobbies into careers. He provided real-world examples that offered motivation and practical insights, showcasing effective strategies for transforming passions into successful professional paths and encouraging students to actively pursue their interests. The interactive nature of the lecture allowed students to actively participate in discussions, ask questions, and engage in self-assessment activities. The session proved to be a valuable experience, offering both inspiration and actionable guidance for future career planning.

Outcome:

1. Students were inspired by the young speakers' success stories and motivated to actively pursue their own interests and hobbies as potential career avenues.
2. Exposure to young role models who have successfully integrated their hobbies into their careers likely boosted students' confidence in pursuing their own goals.
