3. To instill a sense of social responsibility and community engagement among students and faculty of the Department of Management Studies (MBA) at SITRC, Nashik.

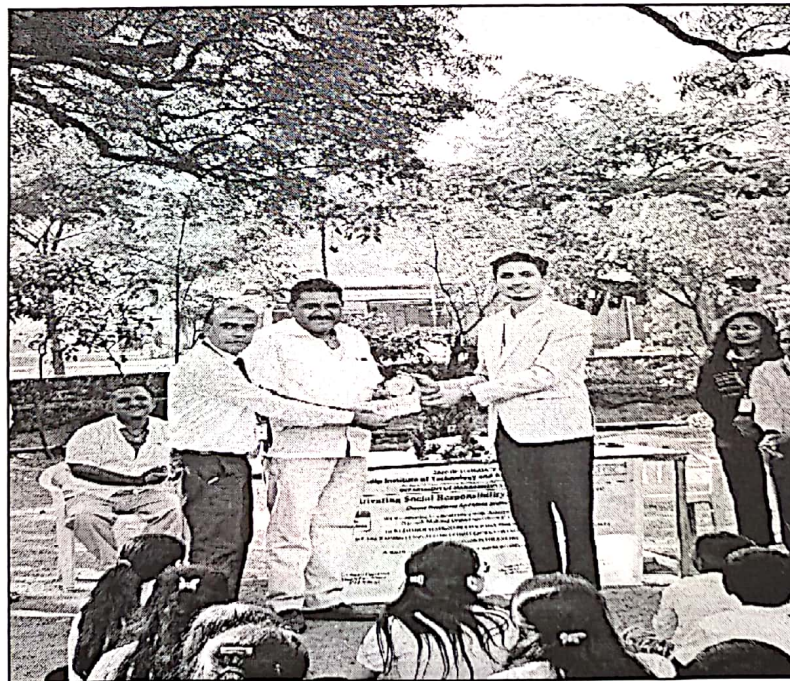
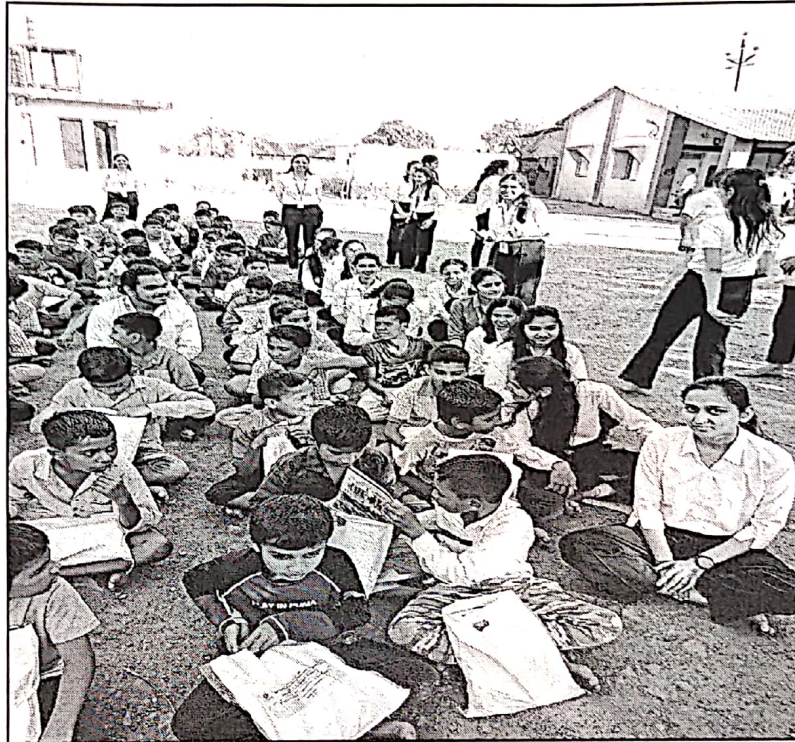
About the Program:

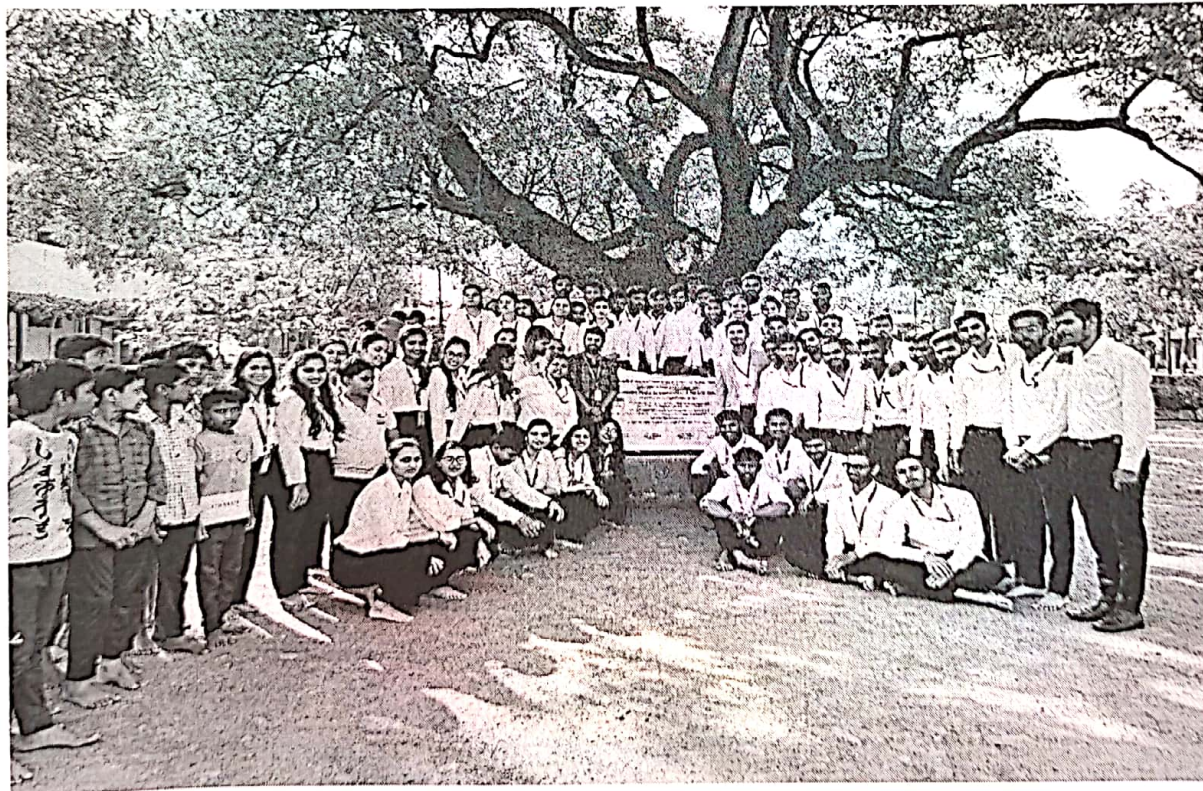
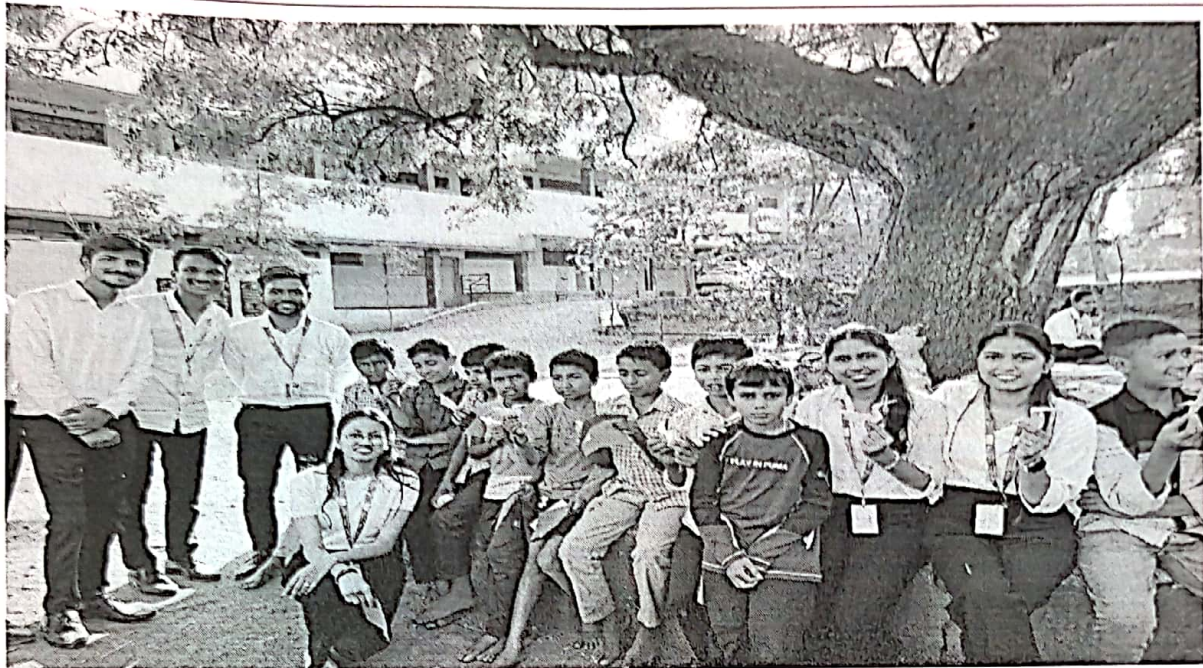
