



Objective:

1. To provide students with guidance on opportunities and procedures for studying abroad.

2. To create awareness about application processes, visa requirements, scholarships, and cultural

3. To motivate and prepare students for international education and career prospects.

About the Program:

The Department of Management Studies organized an informative and interactive session titled "Study Abroad Guidance Session" conducted by Miss Yashashree Tare. The session aimed to enlighten students about the various pathways to pursue higher education in foreign countries.


Miss Tare began by outlining the benefits of studying abroad, including exposure to global education standards, cultural enrichment, and enhanced career opportunities. She detailed the step-by-step process of applying to universities abroad, including selecting the right country and course, preparing for language proficiency tests such as IELTS and TOEFL, and compiling the necessary documents for admission and visa applications.

She also discussed scholarship opportunities, financial planning, and how to overcome common challenges faced by international students, such as culture shock and homesickness. The session included practical tips on preparing a strong statement of purpose (SOP), securing letters of recommendation, and understanding the nuances of student visas.


